Seeing Nov and Dec are going to be such busy months for us Mike is trying to arrange things for January so stay

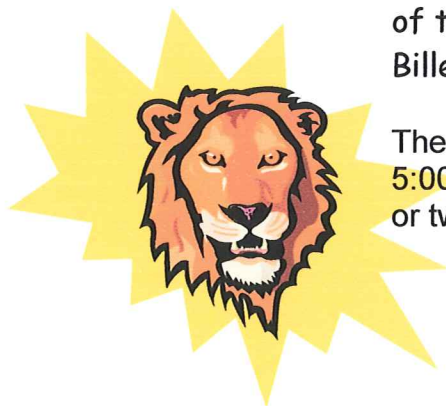
